

Understand that ArcInfo encompasses all of the core ArcGIS functions. I bought this book having the ArcView version of ArcGIS and was unable to complete about 70% of the book. I looked in to upgrading to ArcInfo and found that the price to upgrade is approx \$6000. So if you want this book you really must have the ArcInfo version of ArcGIS or you will not be able to follow through with the book.
